Skills and qualities of this teacher will be: Enthusiastic Creative Industry professionals (ie: photography, tailoring, pottery, multimedia, radio etc) who would like to share their skills and knowledge with individuals from the Fitzroy community. We are looking for someone who can develop an introductory, practical skills-based program for adults who may have never had the opportunity to work in a creative environment. It is an important quality that you have excellent listening and speaking skills, patience and a genuine interest in adult learners. No formal teaching qualification necessary.

The aim of this program is to provide basic skills and experience to low level EAL and Literacy learners to gain English Language vocabulary for Creative Industry programs. Students will gain understanding and experience using technical terms and equipment to a basic level. The program will also provide problem solving opportunities, promote and develop independent learning skills to achieve goals, as well as some practical and industry knowledge.

Outcomes and pathways: Participants should experience improved self-confidence and express themselves creatively, which can lead to employment and/or self-employment, as well as vocational study (VET enrolments).

Hours: An average of 4 hours per week over a 10 week period - total of 40 hours per course - the day and subject area expertise is negotiable (*currently running as a Jewellery course*)

Additional Information:

Please be aware that if you are considering these teaching positions, you will need to develop a program delivery plan and teaching resources and student worksheets/books.

These programs are short course.

Short course are paid at a casual rate of pay, this rate includes an allocation of half an hour per every 1 hour of teaching, for preparation and administration responsibilities. The commencement rate for teaching these programs is \$47.05 per hour.
