3.3	Consider how to encourage use of space by groups with a focus on climate or sustainability	Student Placement / CORE	Dec 23
3.4	Investigate ways to save produce that would otherwise go to waste (i.e. neighbourhood audit of fruit trees, host a food swap)	Student Placement / CORE	Dec 23
